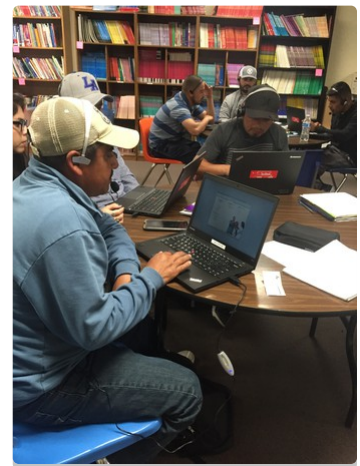

WIOA Title II grant submitted, now a four year cycle

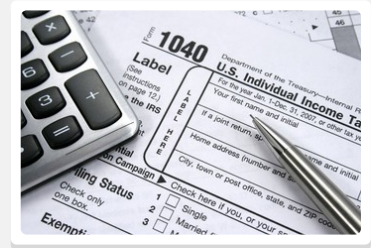
The Adult Education and Family Literacy Act (AEFLA), Title II of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) supports programs that help adults get the basic skills they need including reading, writing, math, English language proficiency, and problem-solving to be productive workers, family members, and citizens.

This federal funding grant has supplemented Salinas Adult School's state funding, California Adult Education Program (CAEP) for a long time. New this year is that the grant is on a four year cycle.



Early Childhood Education Pre-Apprenticeship grant submitted

With encouragement and support from our [Adult Education Consortium \(SVAEC\)](#), Salinas Adult School submitted a planning grant for an ECE pre-apprenticeship that leads to [Hartnell College's ECE Apprenticeship program](#). We are working to help close the gap for qualified childcare providers in Salinas Valley!



Tax Preparation Certification class - Spring 2023

Our **Tax Preparation Course** is designed to give you the knowledge needed to fulfill IRS requirements and give you a basic understanding of tax law and practice to ensure you serve your clients with the highest quality. This study material has been organized to give line-by-line instructions for Form 1040.

In this beginner tax preparer course, you will learn...

- How to prepare a federal individual tax return
- Filing status
- Which form to use
- The importance of safeguarding the taxpayer's documents
- When to use Form 4868.
- The different e-filing options.
- How to complete Schedule 2 of the Form 1040.
- How a nonrefundable credit affects the taxpayer's tax liability.
- Which deductions are limited to the 7.5% floor.

Focus on Careers

The Salinas Adult School is committed to teaching 21st century skills and providing support to our adult students as they transition into new phases of education, employment, parenting, and community engagement. That is our Mission Statement. To that end, we are innovating with Integrated English Literacy and Civics Education (IELCE). This program is an incentive from our WIOA Title II grant that provides funding for developing contextualized ESL classes that are linked to sustainable career paths. 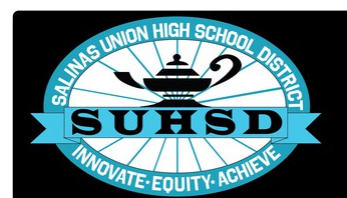

As a department and school governed by the Salinas Union High School District, the Salinas Adult School is committed to being a value-added service to our District. We serve parents and community members. We offer our services throughout Salinas by maintaining collaborative partnerships to host adult classes all over our community at convenient locations to accommodate working parents.



Funding Changes on the Horizon?

The Legislative Analyst Office (LAO) released the [Redesigning California's Adult Education Funding Model](#) brief on December 15, 2023. In the brief, the LAO provides background on adult education funding, assesses the current funding model, and offers recommendations to improve it. The new

adult education funding model recommendations include: establishing uniform base per-student adult education funding rate; adding a performance component to funding for adult schools and CCC noncredit programs; eliminating fees for adult school courses; allocating some CAEP funding directly for consortium-level activities; adjusting funding allocations annually to account for key cost drivers; and phase in a new funding model over several years.
